# Leeds Savage Club

Leeds Savage Club was founded in 1898 by writer and art dealer Edmund Bogg, along with painters Owen Bowen & Mark Senior, architect Percy Robinson, sculptor Edward Caldwell Spruce, and cartoonist J.H. Dodgson. Bogg came to Leeds in the 1870s, working as a joiner & artist's colourman. He gathered a group of artists around him and the first meeting of the club, based on the London Savage Club, was held in January 1899 at Owen Bowen's studio. Leeds Savage Club, which included artists, musicians and writers, set their own rules based on a Native American theme, with the committee of 'braves' and meetings referred to as 'pow-wows'. Although likely to have been well-meaning at the time, today this would raise issues of cultural appropriation. The club also only admitted men. However, many of the members were influential in the development of Leeds as a city, and funds were often raised for charitable causes. The club was active for over ten years, with the last recorded meeting held in October 1912. Memorabilia related to Leeds Savage Club are held in Leeds City Museum, and Local & Family History Library have various books and literature.
